Correlation Between Listening English Song and Speaking Abilty at the 4th Semester in English Department of Madura University

Abstract

The purpose of this research was to examine whether there was a correlation between listening English song and speaking ability of 4th semester students at the English Department of Madura University. This research applied quantitative research and used correlation design. The population of this research were fourth semester students at the English department, the total number were 39 students. The data collecting technique that used were questionnaire and reading test. The result of the hypothetical of the research showed that the value of rxy was higher than rtable (0,910 > 0,316). Thus, it can be concluded that H_a is accepted and H_o is rejected. It means that there is a correlation between reading interest and reading comprehension ability of 4th semester students at the English Department of Madura University. Then, based on the interpretation rxy 0,910 shows that the correlation between students' listening English song and speaking ability is in the weak correlation category, in which between 0.8-1.0.

Suharja research focus on listening song, it can be concluded that students' listening ability denoted a positive an effect to their speaking. In this case, he founds the correlation of listening song to the students' speaking performance in EFL context. The result of this research is, it has correlation between listening songand speaking comprehension.

CONCLUSION

Based on the research finding in the previous chapter, it can be concluded that there is a significant correlation between listening English song and speaking ability. The research shows that the correlation in the high level, 0.910. Then, when it was tested by the significance contribution, it shows that the result was significant. The score of too is bigger than table, in which 0.910 > 0.316. Therefore, the researcher summarizes that listening English song really gives contribution and has correlation to the ability of speaking. A good speaking performance is gotten from the listening skill. The better listening the students have the better speaking they will perform.
